GTAI NIGERIA REPORT



A number of people from different spheres of the nation have become aware of the aim/objectives of GTAI and have been enlisted as members.

An ad-hoc leadership team spread over the country had been set up for the group in Nigeria.

We have been working on the formal registration of the organization for a while now, with picking of an acceptable name to CAC being a challenge.

In the interim, we had identified for pursuit two projects;

SHORT TERM

- (i) Enhancing the IT center in a school in Lagos (Badore model School) or
- (ii) Renovating a classroom block in the school.

LONG TERM

Working with an NGO in Lagos to establish a 500 capacity Women Skills acquisition/empowerment campus.

GTAI Nigeria has been in attendance at the various Summits in Spain. In the last Summit, Nigeria was voted as the next country of focus for GTAI International forum as presently being done in Uganda.

Uganda has been lucky to be chosen as the headquarter for this divine and timely initiative that is GTAI and as a result alot is taking place already;

VANU LICENCE: VANU is an innovative telecom company and in April 2018 during one of the Annual GTAI conferences in Valencia Spain, Andy Beard from VANU made a presentation about his company and what it can do in Africa for Africans following a number of African challenges that were presented by various delegates one of which was telecommunications network coverage especially in the rural areas of Africa.



"At GTAI we believe that there should be parity for each and every one and that people in the rural areas should not be left behind."

Remember one of our main agendas is technological emancipation for all Africans yet this cannot be achieved without good and reliable Tele-connectivity.

After VANU's presentation it was established that they were the best fit for rural telephony and connectivity because it's model and innovation would allow most African countries to be covered 100%.

The VANU model uses economical solar powered towers configured to serve the small and sparsely populated areas being able to cover less than 1km radius, covering a population of less than 300 people and a population density of less than 50 people per square Km. This is not something that MNOs (Mobile Network Operators) or traditional tower companies are able to do due to their network infrastructure economics.

With this VANU innovation, we realised that its possible for the rural to enjoy the same teleconnectivity as the urban thus realising our parity objective.

Together with VANU, GTAI has acquired a trading licence and an application for the operating licence was submitted.

THE RCDF PROJECT:

Rural Communications Development Fund is a Ugandan government program under which they established more than 1300 ICT labs through Uganda Communications Commission (UCC) to facilitate ICT penetration in the country and they have since had challenges in maintaining the labs.



GTAI had a meeting with Nyombi Thembo, the Director of RCDF to chart a path for a PPP so that we can bring on our partners and internal expertise to run and manage these labs at a subsidized cost and also provide world class certifications from key players such as Microsoft to make the young people competitors on the world stage.




FIGURE 3 How does blockchain work?



Africa Water Solutions (AWS) is a not-for-profit organisation registered to mitigate Water, Sanitation and Hygiene challenges in Uganda with her primary focus being children. The organization purposes to empower beneficiaries with improved access to safe Water, Sanitation and Hygiene using Community Centered Design Approaches (CCDA).

Her geographical scope includes; Namayingo, Tororo, Kumi and Soroti districts in Eastern Uganda, Buikwe district in Central Uganda, Kabale, Rukiga and Kanungu districts in South-Western Uganda, as well as Pakwach, Zombo and Nebbi districts in the West Nile region.



PROJECT GOAL

By 2024, AWS in patnership with GTAI will have contributed to the reduction of water scarcity and related diseases among 34,540 households and institutions (10 schools and 4 health centers) through improved access to safe water, Sanitation and Hygiene.


